Here's what you need to know:

Who is The Chrysalis Fund?

The Chrysalis Fund (TCF) is a women's membership-based group of community minded philanthropists who pool their resources to promote growth and positive change in children, youth, and families. They award grants to local charities that support this mandate.

Can I give to any organization?

You can give to any registered not-for-profit organization in the Southeast region.

What is the value of the grant?

TCF will provide one \$500 grant to a recipient to donate to a cause they are passionate about. Pretty awesome, right!?

When/How to apply:

The deadline to apply for the program is October 31 and a recipient will be chosen by end of November. The grant must be donated within 12 months. The funds will be given directly to the charity from TCF on behalf of the youth recipient.
